Will wind and solar light up Brazil's power?

The post Hope shines in Brazil as wind and solar light up over 34% of the nation's power appeared first on Cleantech Times. Brazil has achieved a remarkable milestone in August 2025. For the first time ever, wind and solar energy together generated more than one-third of the country's electricity.

Why is Brazil reshaping its energy mix?

Ember said the rapid growth of wind and solar helped Brazil avoid similar surges this year. Wind and solar power are also reshaping the country's energy mix. In 2024, they generated 24% of Brazil's electricity, more than double their share from five years earlier.

Are wind and solar power reshaping Brazil's energy mix?

Wind and solar power are also reshaping the country's energy mix. In 2024, they generated 24% of Brazil's electricity, more than double their share from five years earlier. Solar power grew from just over 1% of generation in 2019 to 9.6% in 2024, while wind climbed from 8.8% to 15% over the same period.

How much energy does Brazil produce?

Brazil generated 92.8% of its electricity from low or zero carbon sources during the first nine months of 2023. It produced more clean power by proportion of overall output among all G20 countries in 2022, with a share of 89.1%, according to global energy thinktank Ember.

Will Brazil lead the world towards 100% zero-carbon electricity by 2040?

Ember notes: 'Brazil is well-positioned to lead the way as the world moves towards 100% zero-carbon electricity by 2040.' In July 2023, it generated a record 27% of electricity from wind and solar – 10 TWh from wind and 4 TWh from solar. But hydro remains the main source of electricity, accounting for 73% in 2022.



How does diversifying energy sources strengthen Brazil's energy system?

By 2024, they had fallen to 79 million tonnes. Brazil's experience shows how diversifying energy sources strengthens the system. With more clean power in the mix, the country has managed to grow its economy, meet rising electricity demand, and reduce its reliance on fossil fuels—all at the same time.
