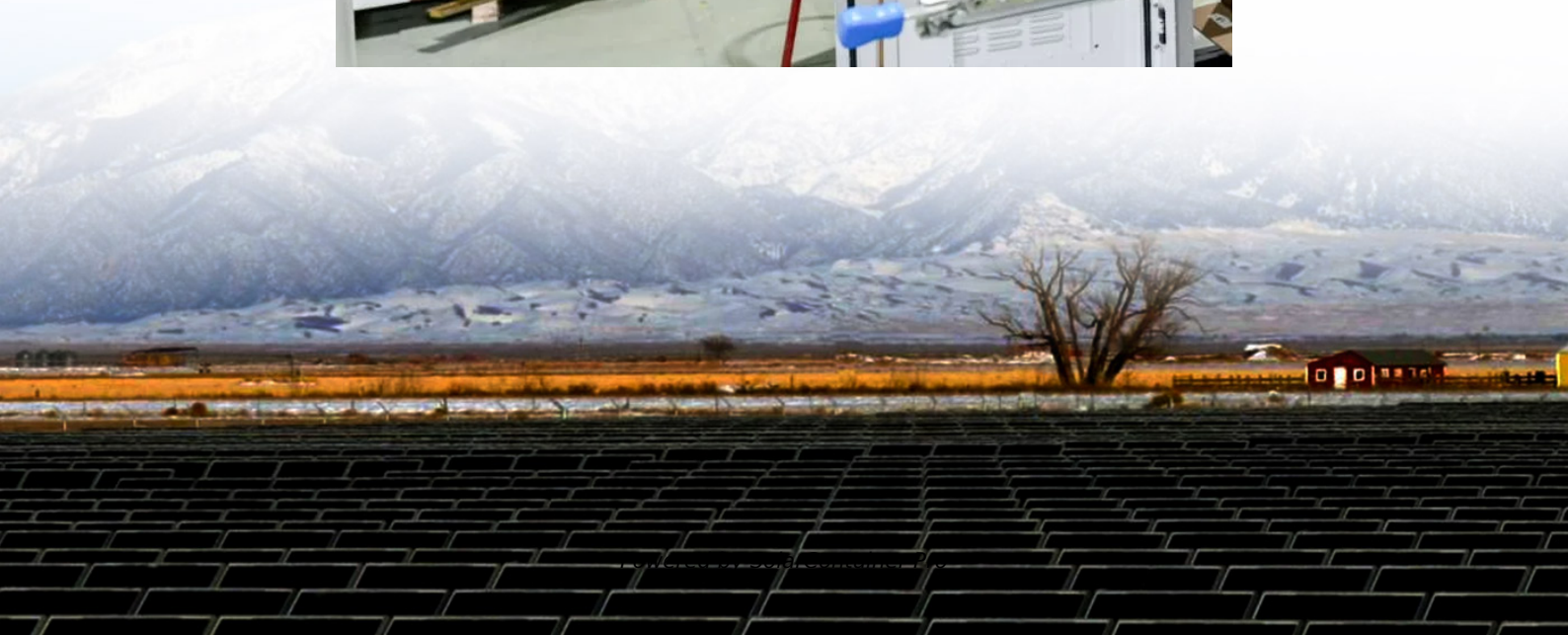


Can I bring lithium batteries to the Marshall Islands





Overview

Larger lithium-ion batteries (101-160 Wh) may be permitted, but you need airline approval first. Spillable batteries are generally forbidden, with exceptions for certain mobility devices. Always pack batteries carefully to prevent damage or short-circuiting. Can you take a lithium ion battery on a plane?

The FAA imposes size limits on lithium-ion batteries. Batteries with a capacity of up to 100 watt-hours (Wh) are unrestricted and can be carried freely. However, if a battery falls between 100 Wh and 300 Wh, it requires the airline's approval before transport. Batteries exceeding 300 Wh cannot be taken on passenger flights.

Small lithium batteries inside devices like phones and laptops are generally permitted in carry-on luggage. However, spare batteries must be properly protected and carried in your cabin baggage, never in checked luggage. Can you bring a battery on a plane?

Requirements vary based on the type of device and size of battery. Spare (uninstalled) lithium metal batteries and lithium ion batteries, portable rechargers, electronic cigarettes and vaping devices are prohibited in checked baggage. They must be carried with the passenger in carry-on baggage.

Can you carry lithium-ion batteries in your carry-on luggage?



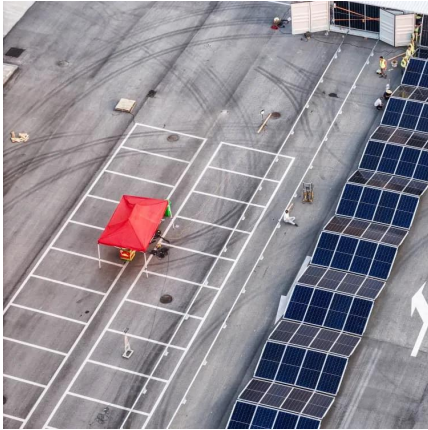
