


How many base station sites are there in the Solomon Islands

Most were built by the US Navy Seabees, Naval Construction Battalions, during World War II as part of the Pacific War. In August 1942 the United States Armed Forces took the Guadalcanal in the Solomon, in the Battl. Naval Base GuadalcanalOne of the major activities of the Naval Base Guadalcanal was support in the building of the airbase.
