How much do solar panels cost on average?

As of 2025, the average cost of residential solar panels in the U.S. is between \$15,000 and \$25,000 before incentives. This typically translates to about \$2.50 to \$3.50 per watt of installed capacity (more on price per watt below). How much does it cost to install and manage solar panels?

According to studies by the U.S. Department of Energy, the all-in cost of a home solar panel system is between \$2.74 to \$3.30 per watt. 1,2,12 This figure includes the solar panels, the installation, and other expenses.

How much does a 12 kW solar panel cost?

The average cost of a 12 kW solar panel installation on EnergySage is \$20,754 after the federal tax credit. You'll probably save anywhere from \$34,000-\$120,000 over 25 years by going solar. Solar panels are just 12% of the total cost of a solar panel installation.

How much do solar panels cost per square foot?

However, the cost per square foot varies based on the size of the home and unique variables found in every installation. For example, the post-tax credit cost of solar panels for a 2,500-square-foot home is around \$20,000 for a rate of \$7.96 per square foot. But how much do solar panels cost for a 1,500-square-foot home?

How much does it cost to clean solar panels?

Solar panels require very little upkeep. If you're able to clean the solar panels yourself, the only maintenance cost will be the water used to hose them down. If you hire a professional to clean your solar panels, it will cost around \$100 to \$350, on average.



How much electricity does a solar panel produce?

The amount of electricity a solar panel produces is measured in watts and kilowatts (1,000 W = kW). A kilowatt-hour (kWh) measures the amount of energy that a solar panel produces. Keep in mind, most homes need at least 10 to 20 panels to cover their electricity. There are four main types of solar panels:.

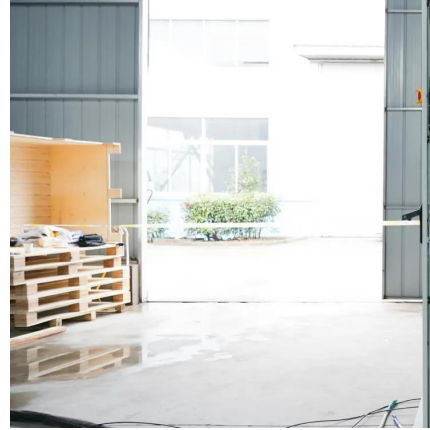
