

How to install container distribution box





Overview

Is distrobox a container manager?

Distrobox itself is not a container manager and relies on Podman or Docker to create containers. From the Distrobox documentation: Use any Linux distribution inside your terminal. Enable both backward and forward compatibility with software and freedom to use whatever distribution you're more comfortable with.

How do I start a distrobox container?

To do so, use the 'distrobox-enter' command. The syntax is as following: When you start the container for the first time, Distrobox will do an automatic initial setup of installing a few containers, setting up the mounts, themes, icons, fonts, groups, users and more. Based on your computer's processing power, this may take quite a long time.

How to Port a distrobox container to a host system?

In case you have an application inside the Distrobox container that you would like to port to the host system, you can do so using the distrobox-export command. But first, access the container's shell. Here, we are going to install Flameshot which is a free and open-source cross-platform tool for taking screenshots.

How to run Linux distributions inside a terminal?

Run Linux distributions inside the terminal. Distrobox is a software tool that allows you to run any Linux distribution inside the terminal. It aims to let you run a variety of software on top of host distribution without any hassle.

Can I install distrobox in my home folder?

Install either distrobox or distrobox-git AUR It is possible to install Distrobox into your home folder if you don't have root access to the system or if you are using an immutable distro. Doing so requires the use of a curl-to-sh pipe which



is an unsupported installation method due to it posing a security risk.

How do I stop a container from running in distrobox?

The first command is 'distrobox list'. As evident from the name, it lists all the containers that are installed. Since I have only one container, only 'fedoraonfoss' showed up, even though it exited a few moments ago. The second command is 'distrobox stop'. This command is used to stop a running container.
