Overview

What is the grid-based electricity situation in South Sudan?

At present, the grid-based electricity situation in South Sudan is characterized by routine power outages and lack of efficiency in the distribution system . In fact, in 2020, 580 GWh or nearly $100\,\%$ of electricity was produced from oil and gas, and just $1\,$ GWh from renewable sources .

What is South Sudan's role as a power utility?

Its role as a power utility is expected to intensify as programmes to increase electricity access in South Sudan are implemented. It is proposed under the Electricity Bill 2015 as the regulatory entity for the electricity sector in South Sudan. It would function as the energy regulator whose functions would include the creation of regulations.

Does South Sudan have a real energy infrastructure?

The situation in South Sudan, the world's newest country, is unique. It does not have any real existing energy infrastructure.

What are the main energy sources in South Sudan?

The most commonly-used energy sources are biomass and petroleum products. Forests, animal wastes, agricultural residues, and sugar cane are all biomass resources in South Sudan. The country's reliance on oil pervades all aspects of the economy, accounting for roughly 72 % of the 700 Ktoe total primary energy supply.

Does South Sudan have a decentralized power system?

Most decentralized power systems in South Sudan are operated by private companies, NGOs and humanitarian organizations in South Sudan. In assessing the capacity of the off-grid electricity in terms of Megawatt (MW), the kVA rating of the generators and the power factor were taken into consideration.



Does South Sudan have electricity?

As a result, the majority of the nation's electricity is produced by thermal sources, and supply is only available in a few urban centers, notably the capital Juba, Wau, and Malakal. Compared to neighboring countries, South Sudan has the lowest access to electricity (% of population) with only $7.7\,\%$ as of 2021.


