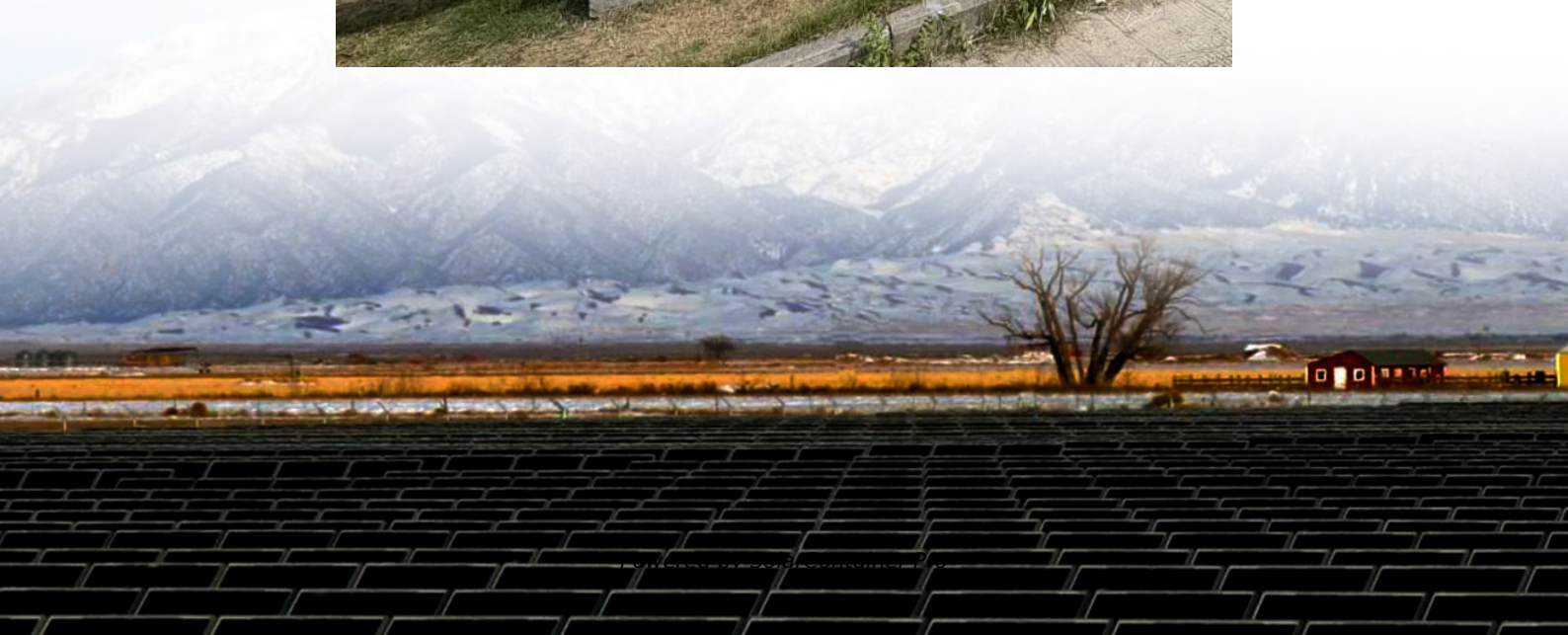


What are the communication base stations in Bhutan





Overview

Internet Service Providers: Bhutan's main and only ISP is Druknet, owned by Bhutan Telecom. It provides a dial-up service, at a reasonable cost. Internet cafes: Located in most large towns. Radio Waves, a radio station is located in Thimphu, Bhutan.

Bhutan Broadcasting Service, established in 1973 and given its current name in 1986, operated under the auspices of the Department of Information; it offered thirty hours a week of shortwave radio programming in Dzongkha, Tshanglakha, Nepali, and English.
